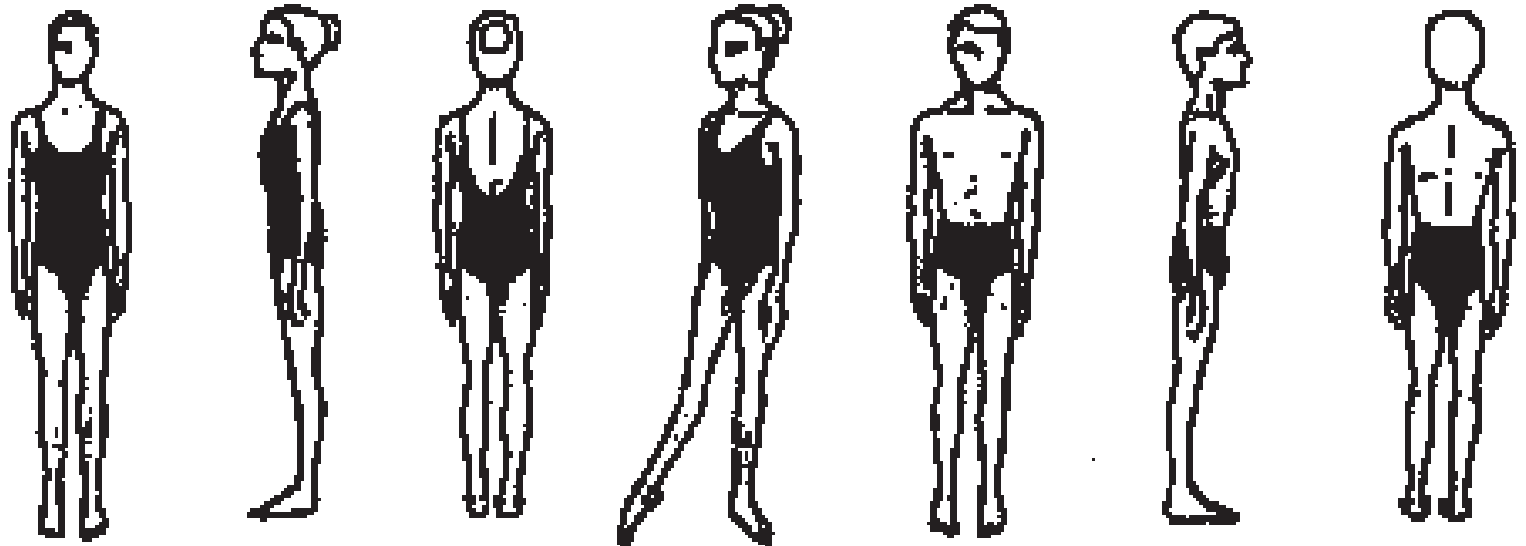

Mission statement

'The aim of the scheme is to help identify and assist children with exceptional potential, regardless of their personal circumstances, to benefit from world-class specialist training as part of a broad and balanced education, which will enable them, if they choose, to proceed towards self-sustaining careers in music and dance.'

Statement agreed by the MDS Ministerial Advisory Group, 5 March 2001

School policy

At Elmhurst, the MDS focuses on classical ballet training in the Lower School (Years 7 – 11) with continuity of means-tested support for the most talented children entering Year 7. Under present arrangements, these Aided Places are allocated to the most gifted and eligible children aged 11 years on entry to the school each September. Subject to successful artistic appraisal in Year 9, MDS funding continues until the completion of Year 11.

MDS pupils in Year 11 who successfully audition for Sixth Form entry may continue to receive DfES funding through the award of a Dance & Drama Award.

Occasionally, Aided Places become available as the result of the withdrawal of award-holders from the Lower School. In this event, in order to identify the most deserving recipients, non-supported pupils from all Lower School year groups are artistically assessed alongside external candidates who have successfully auditioned for entry to the school.

Financial support

The Music & Dance Scheme is a means-tested scheme open to children who satisfy the age and UK residence qualifications. The level of funding provided is dependent on the gross parental income in the household where the child normally resides, with an allowance given for other dependent children in the household. As these notes are meant for general guidance only, it is not appropriate to go into the specific details of the scheme, but should any parent wish to discuss individual circumstances, please contact the Bursar's office. Set out below are some illustrative examples of the level of contribution parents would be asked to pay for one boarding pupil in the academic year 2008/9. Allow a deduction of £1,745 from total gross income for each additional dependent child.

School trips / activities

The cost of school trips and activities will be added to the next term's fee invoice, as will any additional costs associated with English taught as an additional language.

English as an additional language

EAL Fees (Lower School) £500 per term

In the Upper School, EAL can replace one AS or A level option for which no fee is payable. However, the School reserves the right to arrange extra language tuition if it is considered essential for an Upper School pupil. This will be agreed with the parents/guardians before the student commences this tuition, which will be charged at the rate of £35 per hour.

NB Bupa costs for those with an MDS Aided Place are absorbed by the Scheme.

All pupils are automatically included in the School Fees Protection, Permanent Disability and BUPA Schemes (the respective premiums being added to the termly fees) unless parents make other arrangements. Information in relation to these Schemes will be provided by the Finance Director's office upon request. However, parents are urged to obtain independent professional advice about any insurance scheme.

Bursaries

For full fee paying pupils a limited number of means-tested bursaries are available.

The Governors reserve the right to amend all fees at their discretion, but normally, one term's notice is given of any changes. All fees are payable termly in advance, otherwise the school reserves the right to refuse admission. A full term's notice in writing or payment in lieu of notice is required of a pupil's intention to leave. Should any pupil in receipt of an MDS Aided Place be withdrawn without any such notice being given, it is part of the contract between the school and the parent that the parent shall pay the full fee (not just the parental contribution) for the following term in addition to any outstanding fees or costs for the term in which the pupil is withdrawn. A term's notice also applies to the cancellation of private tuition.
