

Lower School Academic Results 2009

We are truly delighted with the achievements of our students in this year's GCSE examinations. These results are indeed testament to the hard work and determination of our students.

The results also demonstrate the dedication of a team of teachers who are able to support and stimulate students to achieve and exceed their potential.

These results are even more impressive when seen in the context of a vocational school which does not select on academic ability.

In Year 10 students are encouraged to take GCSE examinations early. The results for 2009 are as follows:

Out of a cohort of 30

In academic dance all 30 students achieved at least grade B with 97% achieving grade A*-A.

Five students sat mathematics a year early with 100% success at grade B or above 80% achieving grade A*-A.

One student sat music a year early and achieved grade A*.

One student sat AS French two years early and achieved grade A.

Year 11 results 2009

Out of a cohort of 16 students

100% of students achieved at least five A*-C grades.

95% of the cohort achieved at least 5 A*-C grades including English and mathematics.

56.25% of the cohort achieved at least five A*-C grades including English, mathematics, science and MFL.

Outstanding individual performances:

Three students achieved at least ten A*-A grades

One of these students achieved 9A* and 2 A grades.
