

## **Directions to Elmhurst School**

**N.B.** Please be aware that the School site is not always recognised by Satellite Navigation Systems.

### **Via M5 travelling from the South**

- Exit Junction 4 (one after J4A for M42) and follow A38 into Birmingham, through Rubery, Longbridge, Northfield and Selly Oak, and past the entrance to Birmingham University on your left.
- The A38 again becomes dual carriageway after the University entrance and passes King Edward VI Boys School on your left. As you drive past a turning on your right (Pebble Mill Road with overhead traffic lights), signal that you are turning left. Look for the white walls and wrought iron gates of Elmhurst School for Dance on your left.
- The entrance to the school is approximately 200m before a major junction with traffic lights where the A38 crosses Priory Road (B4217)

### **Via M6**

- Exit the M6 at Junction 6 onto the A38M towards Birmingham City Centre. The A38M becomes the A38. Continue on A38 and go under Birmingham via two tunnels and an underpass towards M5 and Bromsgrove.
- Continue on A38 and drive straight over the first major traffic junction (A4540 crosses) which has a McDonalds Drive Thru' diagonally opposite, on your right.
- Continue straight over the next traffic lights (Edgbaston Cricket Ground and Moseley signposted left) and very shortly after you will drive past the entrance to Elmhurst School on your right (white walls and wrought iron gates), at this point move in to the right hand lane. It is not permitted to turn right at this point so continue for approximately 100yds past the school, to the filter off the right hand lane, which allows you to turn back on yourself and approach Elmhurst School from the opposite direction.

## Via M40/ M42

- Exit the M40 (right hand lanes) onto the M42 travelling 'West' signposted M5, Birmingham South etc.
- Exit M42 at Junction 3 and turn right at the roundabout towards Birmingham on the A435
- Continue on A435 heading into Birmingham. At the second roundabout - the landmark here is a large Sainsburys - the dual carriageway will become single lane as you take the second exit to follow the A435 through Kings Heath.
- Stay on A435 along Kings Heath High Street. As you come out of Kings Heath, take the left fork at traffic lights into Queensbridge Road.
- Follow Queensbridge Road and go straight over the mini roundabout onto Russell Road.
- Turn left at next roundabout and continue past the Edgbaston Cricket Ground on your right and Cannon Hill Park on your left. Proceed straight over the traffic lights at the first major road junction (A441) after the cricket ground.
- At the next set of traffic lights, turn left onto the A38. The school is approximately 50 yards on your right (white walls and wrought iron gates). Move into the right hand lane. It is not permitted to turn right at this point so continue for approximately 100yds past the school, to the filter off the right hand lane which allows you to turn back on yourself and approach the school from the opposite direction.

## Alternative Means of Transport

**Birmingham New Street** is the nearest main line train station to Elmhurst and the taxi journey, like the bus, takes approximately fifteen minutes

### Bus

The numbers 61, 62 and 63 stop outside New Street Station, the journey time varies depending on the time of day, but normally takes fifteen minutes. Correct change is required on Birmingham buses, the current full price fare is £2.20.
